Get feedback from staff when issues are being dealt with	This year YGL have been class based and immediate feedback has been challenging because they have been teaching. From September we will have phase leaders who are not class based and therefore there will be capacity for more immediate feedback around issues. Please note a phase leader will be across two-year groups and will be on the playgrounds at designated spots both at drop off and pick up times.
