What would you like to see improve this year?

Thank you for your helpful comments about what we can do to improve. We will, of course, look at all of these but there are also some common themes.

More communication in relation to learning (including SEN) and events	There are already numerous opportunities to see and discuss your child's learning including 'come and see' events and parents consultations. We have been trialling class dojos as an in class reward system- with this does include a parent App which is also currently being trialled in one class room We use parent share in the Early Years which is designed that you are able to share your child's learning from home into their learning journey. In order for parents to see what their child has been learning in school, we have developed and trialled the blog in reception and year 1 to astonishing success and we will be looking at how this can be rolled out to all year groups. The Blog (the website https://www.cliftonvilleprimary.co.uk/blog-whats-been-happening-in-year-r-and-1/) . The Headteachers newsletter also highlights the blog and other learning across the school. We recognise that Facebook could also be used more in this way and this will be an ongoing project ensuring that we are celebrating and publishing even more the amazing successes of our children and school community. The newsletters do contain information about what the children will be learning and more information can be found on the website at https://www.cliftonvilleprimary.co.uk/curriculum-this-page-is-under-development/ We do send a lot of texts out and we are very aware of not to bombard parents too much and that sometimes information relating to events may get lost amongst the school dinner menus. From September we will try and publish all events much sooner and will also include an online calendar which you can download into your own calendar. If your child has additional needs (SEND) then you have the opportunity to discuss their SEND provision three times a year (at PCE) with the class teacher. There is also the opportunity to discuss your child's needs further with the SENDco by emailing sendco@cliftonville primary.co.uk
Size of the school vs building	We have grown over the last 6 years to being 4 -form throughout. We are now at capacity. We are constantly looking at the site and making improvements to support the children's learning both inside and out. One of these improvements is moving the library into a larger space in the heart of the school- whilst still accessible from the outside, this will reinvent our library and ensure that all children can enjoy all the magic and mystery that a library can offer.
Rewards	We have spent a great deal of time this year thinking about how we use rewards across the school and will be updating our system across all year groups including the linking of our values to class dojo system.
